

We also have severe reservations about the increased density that would result from the changes. Again, the number of residential units was argued over at length and our view is that an extra 40 units would not be sustainable.

Overall, therefore, we would not be able to support the proposals. We would expect Linden in any case to adopt the maximum eco-friendly measures, without increasing the marketable accommodation. We are of course ready to meet to discuss the issue, but thought that first you should be aware of the strength of our feeling.
